[YOUTH HOSTELS ASSOCIATION OF INDIA](#) is a non-political, non-sectarian, non-governmental organization registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI 1860 and affiliated to the International Youth Hostel Federation. It is also recognized by the Ministry of Education as an organization promoting youth welfare in the country.

The membership card issued by the Association entitles the holder to use any of the nearly 5,000 Youth Hostels all over the world.

OBJECTS

The main objects of the Association are as follows –

1. To help all persons, in particular, young persons of limited means, living and working in industrial or other areas to acquire a greater knowledge, care and love of the countryside, its beauty spots, historic sites and buildings etc. by providing hostel or other simple accommodation for them on their travels and thus promote their health, rest and education.
2. To foster friendly relations between the urban and the rural population
3. To promote inter-state contacts and
4. To promote international friendship without distinction of color, class or creed, particularly by the provision of facilities for young people from other countries to travel in India and vice-versa

INSTITUTIONAL MEMBERSHIP is open to any school, college or such other educational institution, which subscribes to the aims and objects of the Association.

Every institutional member gets four Leader Cards, each of which can be used by any staff member to take with him four non-member students from the same institution for using YH facilities. This effect means that the institution gets twenty memberships in lieu of the Institutional Membership fee paid.

In addition, any staff member or student from a member institution who wishes to obtain an individual membership card can avail the membership as follows –

- [Junior Membership](#) (11 to 18 years) – **Rs.60/-**
- [One year Membership](#) (18 years and above) – **Rs.150/-**
- [Two year Membership](#) (18 years and above) – **Rs.250/-**
- [Life Membership](#) (18 years and above)- **Rs.2000/-**
